



RESIDENT DIDACTICS

More than One Way to Teach

Traditional Lecture with Visual Aide - create a PowerPoint/Keynote presentation and explain each slide while advancing through the deck

"Chalk Talk" - explore a topic verbally while annotating your thoughts on a white board or chalk board as you go

Case-Based Discussion - present a case, real or fictional, that illustrates points on your topic. Ask questions of learners as you go and discuss.

Board Style Q&A - select relevant board-style questions, give learners time to answer, and supplement the explanation verbally

Flipped Classroom - assign pre-work (recorded lecture, podcast, reading) and use in-person time to clarify points and apply to cases/questions

Journal Club - select a noteworthy journal article and assign portions of the article to residents to discuss, analyze, and teach
